Scholarships – The WTC Foundation Scholarship is open for applications. We are gearing up for another busy scholarship year, with applications for 2024-2025 due April 5, 2024. Applications are available by fillable PDF and electronic JotForm on the WTCalumni.com website. Today, four applications have been received: two by PDF and two by JotForm.

I have made substantial efforts to spread the information about scholarship applications to all offices on campus that have direct contact with students. I have also used social media to spread the word and am promoting academic and CTE programs on Facebook to increase our scholarship applications and boost enrollment.

A generous donation of \$10,000 has been received from Pam Browning to benefit the Stacey James Browning Memorial Scholarship available to Scurry County or Borden County graduates in the 2024-2025 academic year. Mrs. Browning contributed, intending to provide immediate support for students at WTC. Mrs. Browning also stated she has plans to make an additional \$10,000 contribution to establish an endowed scholarship to provide for the legacy of Stacey and our community.
