- support for art, music, and cultural programs
- sponsorship of distinguished lecturers
- improvements to physical campus space

Eligibility: Any full-time Staff, Faculty, or Administrator of Western Texas College.

**Amount:** Up to \$5,000

- Is this project aligned with the vision for WTC?
- Evaluation how will they evaluate the success of the project?
- Clarity and completeness of proposal
- Special consideration given to projects where additional sources of funding are available to help fund entire budget.

## Inspire Grant Project Proposal: The Dude Court Renovation

### A.

- a. Detailed Description of the proposed activity or program.
  - i. There will be two benches installed on either side of the court along with repainting of the court to have court lines and marking.
  - ii. Two new basketball backboards, rims, and nets will be purchased and installed.
  - iii. A light will be installed to provide use of the renovated court day or night.
- b. The completion of the proposed renovation will benefit students to get outside and stay active, interact with other students, and have fun! Bringing life to a space that seems uninviting and nonexistent will brighten up another location on campus. It is my hope that I will continue to see more students utilizing the newly renovated space and enjoying their time here at Western Texas College. Another bonus would be adding customized, engraved, plaques that are dedicated in honor of The National Society of Leadership and Success and Phi Theta Kappa Chapters of WTC. Showcasing those honor societies, that I am personally a part of at WTC, would promote awareness and encourage other students to pursue the highest level of academic excellence.
- c. Once approved for the requested funding we can order the benches and have TDI install the new benches at the court. I will also order the new basketball backboard and net to have installed upon arrival. The final task that would have to be planned due to weather, would be the repainting of the court. Once we can get the paint supplies and paint ordered it would be a matter of temperature and condensation.
  - If the purchase of two additional benches is not approved, the current benches located at the sand volleyball court could be relocated to the newly renovated space.
- d. The renovation would be evaluated based on the increased usage of the space by students.
- e. The materials needed to complete the project would be the benches, backboard with rim to install and tools to install those. Paint kit with spray would be all you need to do the markings. The light would need to installed along with tools. Benches would need to be installed into the ground.
- f. If the amount requested does not fully fund the project, we can reevaluate the cost of the basketball equipment and scale back to a lower-quality item that may not have as long of a warranty or repaint the backboards personally until the opportunity comes around to finish the renovation.

B.

- a. The expenses would consist of the purchase of the benches cost around \$800 each back in 2019. The Bison Baskerball Backboard, Rim, and Padding would cost \$4, 274.00 for two. The court stencil kit will be \$189.00, and the solar outdoor light would be \$149.99. This brings a total of \$4,612.00.
- b. There are no other sources of funding available for this proposal.
- c. I will provide copies of all receipts for approved expenditures.







The backboard is pre-drilled for original DuraSkin backboard padding and is constructed of 1/2" tempered glass, as well as aluminum framework. For great visibility, there is a bright white border and shooters square on the board. The DuraSkin indoor backboard padding comes in 17 different colors, is extremely thick and is constructed of durable foam molded-in steel. The ProTech breakaway goal is made for 42" glass backboards only. It features a heat-treated ball and socket and a positive lock mechanism that provides excellent rebound consistency over the life of the goal. It has a steel cover-plate and continuous netlocks.
